The Society held its Annual Winter Distribution function in the Auditorium of State College of Education, Patiala. Mr. S. A. Ramesh Rangan, M.D., State Bank of Patiala was the Chief Guest. Mr. Inderheet Mahajan, an Industrialist, was the Eminent Guest.

More than 1000 jerseys were distributed to needy students selected from over 100 schools in the District. 20 teachers were also honored for their innovative teaching efforts. 8 people were handed new sewing machines so that they can earn their livelihood and support their families. These students had finished their training in the Society run centers. Six dustbins were also provided to a religious place so that awareness can be raised under Clean India Mission. Mattings, fans and other items were distributed to schools as per their needs.
